Topical Steroid Withdrawal Syndrome is a debilitating condition. Recovery requires discontinuing use of topical steroids - resulting in burning, weeping, flaking skin, as well as systemic steroid withdrawal symptoms. TSW Syndrome comes with severe complications requiring multiple daily interventions for a protracted period of time. Many sufferers are misdiagnosed with little to no medical support, bedridden, and housebound for months to years before symptoms abate.

In January 2012, Palace changed the name to ITSAN.org and was granted 501c3 nonprofit status in February 2012. ITSAN has since evolved into a vast support network from all over the world providing support and creating change.

HOW WE MAKE AN IMPACT

- Creating the only Topical Steroid Withdrawal Patient Registry: encouraging research efforts and making the first estimate of TSW Syndrome prevalence
- Driving research to provide diagnostic criteria and obtain a diagnostic code
- Patient recommended Physician registry: Connecting our patients with doctors who understand how to diagnose and treat TSW Syndrome is a top priority
- Petitioning the FDA for labeling changes to drug inserts for topical corticosteroids
- Active in leadership with the Coalition of Skin Diseases (CSD)
- Lobbying in Washington, D.C. with Coalition of Skin Diseases at annual legislative days
- Representing the TSW community at the International Alliance of Dermatology Patient Organizations (IADPO) Atopic Dermatitis symposium and advocacy events annually.
- Collaborating with Allergy and Asthma Network on their Corticosteroid Stewardship Campaign
- Publishing peer-reviewed, scholarly articles around eczema, treatments, TSW symptoms, and steroid overuse
